

As seen in the Review, the American Dutch Harness Horse Association High Point system is now in effect, to recognize, encourage, and promote horses shown in ADHHA Classes.

2023 ADHHA points will begin at the end of 2022 ADHHA Finals through 2023 ADHHA Finals. To receive points, horses must show in an ADHHA class(s). Non- ADHHA classes will be accepted if there are no ADHHA classes offered OR classes will be accepted if stable/trainer/owner has more than one entry for the same ADHHA class and deems necessary to be shown in another non-ADHHA qualifier class.

Competing horses must have their showing name changed with the ADHHA Office to be eligible for High Point prizes. Horse must have been shown and judged to obtain points for class. Any excussion from or incompletion of the class will void points for that class.
